IMPORTANT NOTES

Table 1 shows the marks for all the students who took the official course exam in the second *appello*. The **mark for the official course** (Translation Studies, *lezioni frontali*) includes the theory part (either midterm tests or standard exam), the translation task and the translation commentary.

Table 2 shows the marks for all the students who took the *esercitazioni* exam in the winter session and those who also took the official course exam in the second *appello*. For the latter, the **final mark** for Translation-English 2 is also provided.

The **final mark for Translation-English 2** is calculated as follows: the score obtained in the Translation Studies component (see above) is multiplied by 2 and added to the score obtained in the language component. This figure is divided by 3.

Students cannot refuse a passing mark (a score of at least 18/30) in any of the single (partial) exams taken towards the final average mark in the course. Only the **final average mark** itself can be refused, obliging the student in that case to take each single exam again. Marks obtained in written exams remain valid for 4 exam sessions, including the session they were taken in.
